



Announcement of Thammasat University

Re: Admission to Bachelor of Nursing Science Programme (International Programme) at Faculty of Nursing for Academic Year 2021

Thammasat University views as proper to open for admission to a bachelor's degree in nursing science (international programme) at the Faculty of Nursing for the academic year 2021, thereby announcing the application and selection timetable as well as other details as follows.

1. Teaching Facility

The study in the Bachelor of Nursing Science Programme (International Programme) of the Faculty of Nursing shall take place at Thammasat University, which reserves the right to change and determine the place of study as appropriate by the resolution of the University Council.

2. Qualifications of Eligible Applicants

2.1 General Qualifications

2.1.1 Being a graduate of or studying in the sixth year of secondary school either domestically or abroad per the Thai or international education system.

Remark: applicants studying at or graduating from abroad or international schools in Thailand must submit the proof of study to the Faculty for consideration in accordance with the Notification of Thammasat University on Thammasat University guidelines for qualifications equivalent to high school B.E. 2562 (2019).

2.1.2 Not being a student of a university or another higher education institution, except for an open university or the remote (online) study that grants a degree.

2.1.3 Not being a patient or in a state that would be a serious obstacle to the education

2.1.4 No moral misconduct or seriously derogatory behaviours

2.2 Specific Qualifications

2.2.1 Being a graduate of or studying in the sixth year of secondary school, must have completed at least a total of 22 credits in basic and additional subjects in the science, physics, chemistry and biology subject group, and at least a total of 12 credits in basic and additional subjects in the mathematics subject group, or be equivalent to grade 12.

2.2.2 United States and Canada education system

- Applicants who took the GED test before May 2017 must score at least 2,250 points in total in five subjects with at least 410 points in each subject.

- Applicants who took the GED test as of May 2017 must obtain test results of four subjects with at least 165 points in each subject equivalent to completing the high school in the art-language or art-math (previously) programme only.

2.2.3 One English test result not older than two 2 years on the application date

1) In accordance with the criteria for the international programme admission stipulated by the University:

- TOEFL, paper-based = 500
- TOEFL, Internet-based = 61
- TU-GET, paper-based = 500
- TU-GET, computer-based = 61
- IELTS = 6.0
- O-NET = 69 (for applicants who have graduated in Thailand)

2) In accordance with the criteria for the conditional international programme admission:

- TOEFL, paper-based = 400
- TOEFL, Internet-based = 32
- TU-GET, paper-based = 400
- TU-GET, computer-based = 32
- IELTS = 4.5
- O-NET = 45 (for applicants who have graduated in Thailand)

2.2.4 Foreign applicants who have graduated from programmes taught in English in countries where English is their official language are exempted from submitting English language test results.

2.2.5 Is healthy with neither underlying diseases nor disabilities that would otherwise hinder his/her education and profession, such as colour blindness even in one eye, blindness, deafness, difficulty in hearing, etc.

3. Twenty People Accepted for Entire Programme

There are two rounds of admission as follows.

Discipline	Inter-Program Admission 1	Inter-Program Admission 2
Bachelor of Nursing Science (International Programme) (regular session)	15 people	5 people

Remark: In the event that the number of accepted people in the Inter-Program Admission 1 does not reach the specified amount, more people will be accepted in the Inter-Program Admission 2 until the specified amount is reached.

4. Application Conditions

4.1 Each applicant has one right to decide which one discipline (s)he is to study in. He/she may apply for multiple disciplines or in any round stipulated in the criteria, but once they are confirmed, (s)he shall not be able to apply in the next selection round. To apply in the next round, the existing confirmation must be waived. The confirmation and the waiver must only be made via the rights management system of the Council of University Presidents of Thailand within the specified period. Such waiver can only be made once. Waivers outside the period are not counted as waivers in the central system.

4.2 Applicants must verify and certify themselves meeting the qualifications in accordance with the admission notification. Should the University subsequently investigate and find that any applicant does not meet such qualifications, (s)he shall be deemed disqualified from admission. Paid application fee shall not be refunded in any case.

5. Selection Method / Selection Criteria

5.1 Selection criteria in the Inter-Program Admission 1 and 2:

5.1.1 The applicant meets the qualifications as declared above.

5.1.2 Selected by interview

5.2 Other conditions:

5.2.1 The eligible applicant must complete the procedure stipulated on this Notification and sit in an interview exam on the specified date and time. Otherwise, his/her admission right shall be considered waived.

5.2.2 The English test score required in the application must not be more than two years from the test date. The best score shall be taken into consideration.

5.2.3 The applicant studying at an international school in Thailand who has not yet completed the study must file a school certificate indicating that (s)he is studying in grade 12 or equivalent, and is expected to complete grade 12 by May 2021, as well as educational results of five semesters of high school, as part of application documents. The applicant must submit evidence showing that (s)he has completed the study to the Faculty of Nursing by 1 August 2021. Otherwise, the applicant shall be disqualified as university students.

5.2.4 The applicant studying abroad who has not yet completed the study must file a school certificate indicating that (s)he is studying in grade 12 or equivalent, and is expected to complete grade 12 by May 2021, as well as educational results of five semesters of high school, as part of application documents.

5.2.5 The applicant studying in the educational system that does not calculate GPAX must file at least one letter of certification of the study and conduct issued by the teacher at the applicant's current institution as part of application documents.

5.2.6 The committee's consideration shall be deemed final.

5.2.7 The applicant shall not be able to request the application fee refund in any case.

6. Application

6.1 Only apply and submit documents online at www.nurse.tu.ac.th.

6.2 Application fee of 1,000 Baht is to be paid in Krungthai Bank Public Company Limited account number 475-3-19100-1; account name: Bachelor of Nursing Science Programme (International Programme).

9. Grading of Basic Knowledge of Foreign Language for Admitted Students

Thammasat University requires that all students who are admitted to the University take the English language and performance test, GREATS, to assess their performance and skills needed in the 21st century as well as to create a system for promoting their performance per the GREATS guideline to ensure that students undertake self-development for their highest quality per their own potential, leading to a successful new generation of leadership in the 21st century.

10. Conditions of Eligible People to Register as University Students

10.1 Must be selected and eligible to study at Thammasat University per this programme

10.2 Must be graduates of the high school (the sixth year of secondary school) or equivalent. If it appears that any person eligible to study does not graduate as such, Thammasat University shall not admit him/her.

If Thammasat University subsequently checks and finds out that any person eligible to study is not completely qualified as required by the University, the eligibility shall be void, and payment shall not be refunded in any case.

10.3 Student registration shall comply with the regulation of Thammasat University on undergraduate studies B.E. 2561 (2018).

11. Tuition Fees

Students are required to pay the tuition fee in accordance with the regulation of Thammasat University on undergraduate lump sum tuition fees in regular projects B.E. 2555 (2012) and its ninth amendment B.E. 2561 (2018) as follows.

Thai students	: 35,300 Baht/semester (23,740 Baht for summer semester)
Foreign students	: 44,850 Baht/semester (28,515 Baht for summer semester)
